- . personal art exhibited in public and private collections: Winnipeg, Calgary, Vancouver, Victoria and Dubai







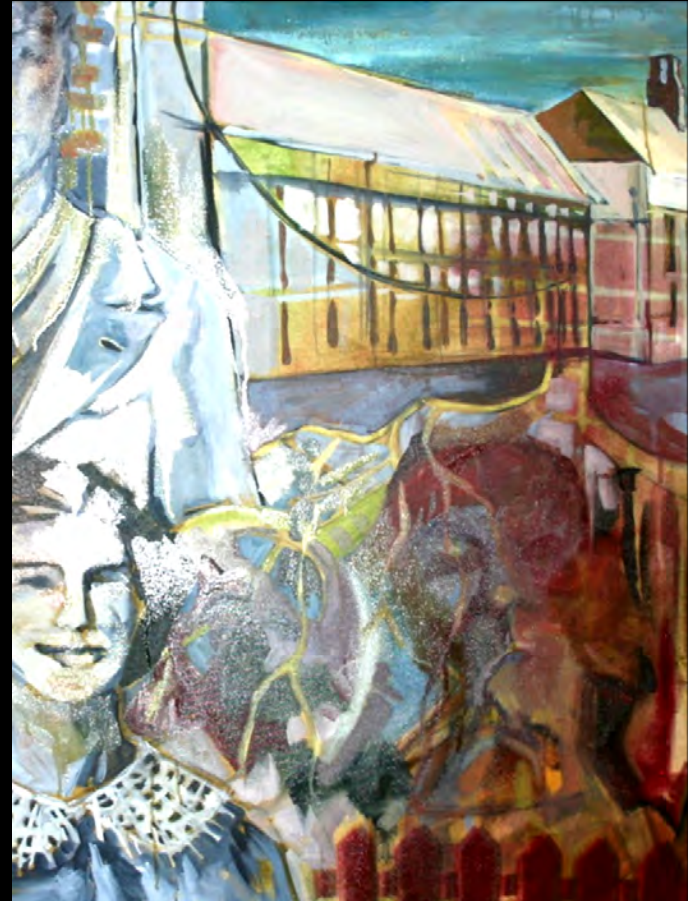
